Be sure the report lists the grade you earned in each course. **Next to each English course completed or in progress, please list the name of your instructor.** You can consult the Schedule of Classes to find the names of your instructors.
3. A typed statement (of **no more than three double-spaced pages**) that expresses your qualifications for the English Honors Program and your career and/or post-graduate plans and goals. In addition to indicating your primary areas of intellectual or academic interest, your statement should explain how you are qualified for the Program, why you are interested in the Program, and what you plan to do following your successful completion of the Program.
